This exciting tour takes in some of Italy's most iconic sights, the hills of Tuscany, the cities of Rome and Florence the romantically rugged landscape of the Apennines and the panoramic views from Sorrento on the Amalfi Coast

ITINERARY

Day 1 Travel to Dover / Folkestone for the short sea ferry / shuttle crossing to Calais and continue to our overnight half board accommodation at the Holiday Inn Garden Court Brussels. www.holidayinn-brussels-expo.com EE

Day 2 We depart after breakfast and travel through the Ardennes to Luxembourg where we have a short stop before continuing the journey into the Black Forest and our overnight half board accommodation at the Baeren Hotel. www.baeren-oberhamersbach.com EE

Day 3 We drive along the shores of Lake Constance into Austria and climb through the Voralburg alpine region to St Anton then along the Inn Valley to Innsbruck. We cross the Europa Bridge at the Brenner Pass and travel into Italy and our 2 nights half board accommodation on Lake Garda. Effe hotels have three hotels in Torbole and we will advise which hotel on your travel ticket. www.efe-hotels.it

Day 4 A day at leisure in resort, time to relax after the previous days travel. Nearby Riva Del Garda is well worth a visit being the second largest town on the northern end of the lake with a pedestrianised medieval old town full of fashionable shops and restaurants.

Day 5 We depart from Rome travelling through Tuscany, Umbria and the Apennine mountains to our 2 nights half board accommodation at the hotel Waldorf, Rome. www.hotelwaldorf.net

Day 6 After a leisurely breakfast we travel to the centre of Rome for our coach tour with a specialist city guide viewing the major highlights such as the Colosseum, Forum and Vatican. We leave the

coach so our tour guide can walk you to the Spanish Steps, Trevi Fountain and Pantheon after which you can enjoy some free time before we re-board the coach and return to the hotel for dinner.

Day 7 After our buffet breakfast we head south past the famous Benedictine monastery at Monte Casino, continuing to the remains of Pompeii, a unique record of how ordinary 1st-century Romans lived their daily lives. Moulds of people and animals were found well preserved, buried under the burning ash. The decoration in some of the excavated villas is amazingly intact. We complete the journey to our hotel arriving with time to relax before dinner. The Montana hotel has recently purchased the Sant'Agata hotel so we may be allocated in either. We will advise which hotel on your travel ticket. www.hotelsantagata.com

Day 8 A leisurely day for you to relax and enjoy the hotel facilities or explore the picturesque resort of Sorrento itself surrounded by magnificent orange groves and famous for its lace and inlaid wood.

Day 9 Today we have an early start travelling by minibus to the port where we board the 8.25am hydrofoil from Sorrento to the sun drenched Isle of Capri, the Island of Dreams. We visit the island by minibus with a guide hopefully with time to browse through the elegant designer shops and enjoy the fabulous views over the Mediterranean Sea.

Day 10 Sadly its time to leave Sorrento and travel north to Florence for our 2 nights half board accommodation at the Hotel Datini. www.hoteldatini.com

Day 11 This morning we have arranged a two hour guided walking tour of Florence. Discover the Ponte Vecchio Bridge, enter the Piazza del Duomo and visit the Cathedral of Florence and the

Baptistry, two of the most important architectural monuments of the Italian Renaissance. During your free time try and visit the Via dei Calzaiuoli, one of the most popular shopping streets in Florence.

Day 12 Today we follow the famous old Roman road the SS1 Via Auralia along the Mediterranean coast to Genoa before heading north to Alessandria and the Aosta Valley and our overnight half board accommodation at the Hotel Rendezvous Aosta. www.hotel-rendezvous.com

Day 13 After breakfast we take the Mont Blanc tunnel into France travelling via Macon and Beaune to our overnights half board accommodation at the Holiday Inn Velizy Paris. www.holidayinn.com/paris-velizy

Day 14 After breakfast we depart for a full day leisurely tour of the city. See Napoleon's Arc de Triomphe, the Avenue des Champs Elysées, Notre Dame Cathedral where the legend of the hunchback was born, the Eiffel Tower, the 18th century Pantheon, Hotel des Invalides, the Louvre and many more of Paris's best known and lesser known sights. This evening we enjoy an evening meal in a Parisian restaurant with a Paris by night illumination tour on the return to the hotel.

Day 15 We leave the hotel after breakfast and return to Calais for the return crossing to Dover / Folkestone and complete the journey home.
