ITINERARY

Day 1 Travel to Dover / Folkestone for the short sea ferry / shuttle crossing to Calais continuing to Vianden to be greeted with a welcome drink before dinner.

Day 2 At leisure in Vianden. Join our guide for a leisurely town walk and explore the narrow streets, gothic churches, ramparts, fortified towers dominated by the magnificent restored castle.

Day 3 We travel to the capital city Luxembourg to meet the guide for our city tour. Luxembourg is a multicultural city split into two districts: the delightful old centre complete with fortress towers, turrets and quaint narrow streets and the more modern downtown area on the Plâteau du Kirchberg. Since 1994, the fortifications and the old city have been classed as a UNESCO world heritage site. Here you will find

an extraordinary network of 23km of underground galleries, the famous casemates, which were carved from the city's rocks constitute the city's main attraction. The Grand-Duke's residence, the Grand-Ducal palace, has an exceptionally beautiful facade in Flemish Renaissance style.

Day 4 Today we travel to Luxembourg's best known and loved region, Little Switzerland. Witness the rugged cliffs, breathtaking waterfalls, unusual rock formations along with medieval cities, tiny river valleys topped with impressive castles. We visit Echternach, Luxembourg's oldest town, based on an old monastery founded in 698. The old patrician Houses, narrow streets and ancient ramparts have helped the town maintain its medieval appearance.

Day 5 We travel to Calais for the return ferry / shuttle crossing and complete the journey home.
