The Esmeralda offers a high level of comfort with a spacious and inviting lounge with bar at the front of the promenade deck. The restaurant at the front of the main deck can accommodate all passengers at a single sitting and it is a pleasure to relax on the partially covered sun deck. The Esmeralda can accommodate 126 passengers on two decks. All 63 stylishly furnished twin-bedded cabins have picture windows, shower and toilet, satellite television, telephone, a safe deposit box and a continental electricity socket (220 volts). The Esmeralda is air-conditioned throughout. It has a lift between the promenade deck and main deck and a stair lift between the promenade deck and sun deck

ITINERARY

- Day 1** Following your door to door pick up we travel to Dover / Folkestone for the short sea ferry / shuttle crossing to Calais. We continue to our overnight half board accommodation.
- Day 2** We continue to Austria arriving in Linz where we board the MV Esmeralda. Time to settle into your cabin before dinner is served.
- Day 3** Linz to Vienna
We set sail early morning cruising the Danube to Vienna. Enjoy a day's relaxation on board and enjoy the scenery.
- Day 4** Vienna
Enjoy the day at leisure exploring Vienna. We have included a morning city coach tour travelling along the stately Ringstrasse to the most beloved architectural wonder in all of Vienna, St. Stephen's Cathedral.
- Day 5** Budapest
We arrive in Hungary and enjoy our included morning city coach tour of Budapest, one of Europe's most beautiful cities; seven bridges link the ancient hilltop city of Buda and its folk filled taverns with the monuments and museums of more modern Pest.
- Day 6** Bratislava
Cruise to Bratislava, the Slovakian capital with its charming old town and castle. Optional combined walking and special train tour of Bratislava city is available.

- Day 7** Bratislava to Durnstein
We cruise through the terraced vineyards of the Wachau wine region to Durnstein with its medieval cobblestone streets and old burgher houses.
- Day 8** We arrive in the charming town of Melk with flower-adorned streets, perfect for exploring on foot. We offer an optional excursion to the magnificent Convent of Melk with a guided tour and admittance to the convents garden. We continue to Linz and our last night on board ship.
- Day 9** We disembark after breakfast and board our coach travelling to our overnight half board accommodation.
- Day 10** Depart for Calais and the return crossing and complete the journey home.
