The mighty Rhine is Europe's best known river, flowing from the Alps of Switzerland to the North Sea Coast. The most popular cruises tend to concentrate on the spectacular Rhine Gorge, famous for its romantic hilltop castles, vineyards, delightful riverside villages and the Loreley Rock. The Moselle offers a different kind of cruising experience. Whilst the Rhine is very much a "working river", the Moselle is narrower and more idyllic with sloping banks and peaceful vineyards.

The Prinses Christina can accommodate over 100 passengers on three decks. Facilities on board include a forward lounge with a bar, dance floor with extensive views, a separate restaurant and a spacious open air sun deck, which is the ideal spot to relax whilst the passing scenery glides by. There is also a reception area and the ship is fully air conditioned throughout. Cabins have twin beds, shower and toilet.

ITINERARY

- Day 1** Depart from South Wales and travel to Dover for the ferry crossing to Calais. We continue to our overnight's half board accommodation in Belgium.
- Day 2** We continue to Cologne where we board the MV Prinses Christina with time to relax before dinner.
- Day 3** Cologne 06:00hrs - Andernach 14:30hrs. Tour Highlight - Andernach is one of Germany's oldest towns full of medieval half timbered buildings.
- Day 4** Andernach 07:00hrs - Cochem 14:00hrs. Tour Highlight - Cochem lies in the most romantic part of the Moselle Valley. Worth seeing are the remains of the old town wall, the fortified tower and "Balduin's Gate" near the churchyard wall in the "Oberkasse", the "Burgfrieden gate" and gangway, the market-place with its "Martin's Fountain" and the old gabled houses built on steep, narrow alleys.
- Day 5** Cochem 07:00hrs - Boppard 15:00hrs. Tour Highlight - Boppard lies at the foot of an unspoiled wooded mountainous area, which is part of the slate hill of the Rhine's countryside. The town has a pleasant promenade and busy pedestrianised shopping centre.
- Day 6** Boppard 08:00hrs - Ruedesheim 14:00hrs. Tour Highlight - At the heart of Ruedesheim old town is the famous Drosselgasse, a magnet for tourists with live band

entertainment from late morning to midnight. Take the cableway up to Niederwald monument, where you float over the vineyards enjoying a wonderful panoramic view of the Old Town with the mighty river Rhine in the background.

Day 7 Ruedesheim 08:30hrs - Koblenz 12:30hrs. Tour Highlight - Koblenz is situated at the confluence of the mighty Rhine and Moselle rivers surrounded by four low mountain ranges. Its abundance of cultural monuments and historic buildings, its cosy lanes and narrow alleyways, the relaxed and happy atmosphere of its squares and river promenades make Koblenz a friendly town where its guests feel right at home. The view from Ehrenbreitstein Fortress high 118 metres above the Rhine across the river down to "Deutsches Eck" with its re-erected equestrian statue of Emperor William I is simply spectacular.

Day 8 Koblenz 07:00hrs - Konigswinter 09:00hrs / Konigswinter 12:30hrs - Cologne 15:00hrs.

Day 9 Sadly we depart Cologne after breakfast and travel to Calais for the return ferry crossing and complete the journey home.
