Durham Dales and Hadrian's Wall Country

Enjoy a fascinating mix of history and heritage with our scenic tour through some of the most beautiful Northumbrian countryside, quaint villages, the Northumberland National Park and the World Heritage Site of Hadrian's Wall.

ITINERARY

Day 1 South Wales to County Durham, the Land of the Prince Bishops.

Day 2 Travel back in time and enjoy a unique day out at the Beamish Museum. A vast living, working experience depicting life as it was in the late 1800's early 1900's. We then continue to Durham with its imposing Cathedral overlooking the river Wear.

Day 3 Accompanied by our local Blue Badge Guide, we travel into the North Pennines, an area of outstanding natural beauty via the picturesque villages of Edmudbyers and Blanchland, along the banks of the Derwent reservoir. We continue over the high North Pennine Hills into Weardale, one of the Durham Dales, with some of the best panoramas in the region and stunning views of the Dales scenery. We take a break in Stanhope, and then continue our tour over the hills to visit the market town of Barnard Castle located in Teesdale, another of the Durham Dales. We have free time to explore the town and lunch at leisure. We then take a scenic drive through Teesdale via the pretty Durham "Green" villages of

Romaldkirk, Cotherstone, Mickleton and Middleton-in-Teesdale before returning to our hotel.

Day 4 Our tour of Hadrian's Wall and Hexham, led by our local Blue Badge Guide, is a fascinating mix of history and heritage with a scenic tour through some of the beautiful Northumbria countryside and parts of the Northumberland National Park. We visit the market town of Hexham, voted best market town in Britain before continuing our journey into the past with a visit to the World Heritage Site of Hadrian's Wall. We include a guided tour of the Roman Fort of Chesters, the finest example of a Roman Cavalry Fort in Britain with the best surviving remains of a Roman Military Bath House. Our tour continues along the route of the Military Road, to enjoy some of the spectacular and scenic locations of this great frontier and to view the wall at close quarters at one of the viewing locations. Our return journey takes us back along the beautiful Tyne Valley.
