Houses of Parliament and Cabinet War Rooms

The UK Parliament is one of the oldest representative assemblies in the world. The site of the Houses of Parliament is the Palace of Westminster, a royal palace and former residence of kings. Visitors will see the key areas of the estate, such as the Commons and Lords debating chambers and the Queen's Robing Room. The Cabinet War Rooms are a glimpse into the Second World War, and how Winston Churchill, the War Cabinet, and the Chiefs of Staff lived through, and survived the war. This warren of underground rooms below the Government Office Building north of Parliament Square, have been kept exactly as they were during the war, and feature original photos and Wartime memorabilia.
