Betws-y-coed and Blaenau Ffestiniog. We begin our tour stopping at Betws-y-Coed, a pretty village near the Swallow Falls where the river Llugwy flows through a wooded valley. We continue to Blaenau Ffestiniog and visit the Llechwedd Slate Quarry where you can experience firsthand, on their world famous cavern tours, how slate was mined and then see how it is transformed into traditional roofing slate and the famous and beautiful slate fan. 'We include a ride on the 'Miners Tramway'.

5 & 8 day tour

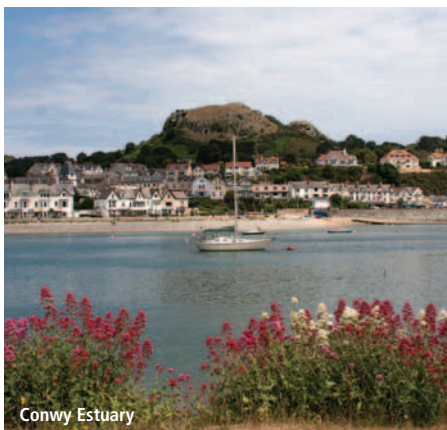
We travel to Caernarfon for a short stop before enjoying a 2 hour single train journey through the fabulous scenery of the Snowdonia National Park on the Welsh Highland Railway. A spectacular 22 mile scenic journey from Caernarfon - climbing over 650ft from sea level as they cross the flanks of Mount Snowdon, before zigzagging dramatically down the steep hillside to reach Beddgelert village, the magnificent Aberglaslyn Pass and on to the new southern terminus at Pont Croesor.

5 & 8 day tour

Today we visit Anglesey visiting Llanfair P.G. and Beaumaris, the site of Edward I last castle. Places to visit are the courthouse built in 1617 and the restored gaol.

8 day tour

A half day tour to Conwy. Its circuit of walls, over three quarters of a mile long and guarded by no less than 22 towers is one of the finest in the World. Visit the picturesque quayside overlooking one of Wales largest recreational boating harbours and look out for the fascinating smallest house. **8 day tour**
