### OUR INCLUDED EXCURSIONS

A half day excursion to Padstow. Padstow is a fine example of a Cornish-fishing port with a colourful harbour surrounded by pastel-washed medieval houses. The town is largely unspoilt, with a beautiful harbour fringed with many intact medieval buildings. The famous "Seafood Restaurant" run by Rick Stein is situated on the quayside. **5 & 6 day tour**

An excursion to Truro and Falmouth. Truro cathedral which was completed in 1910 and incorporates part of the original 16th century parish church and is well worth a visit. Falmouth is an historic maritime town and now home to the National

Maritime Museum. The town's shopping streets lie just off the waterfront and are connected by small alleyways offering tantalizing glimpses of the water and link the harbour with a charming mix of shops and art galleries. Cafés and restaurants offer a selection of local cuisine. **5 & 6 day tour**  
 An excursion to St Ives, one of the most colourful, quaint and attractive towns in Cornwall with numerous granite cottages, small cobbled streets, traditionally painted former fishermen's cottages and narrow alleyways all surrounding a beautiful sheltered harbour. **6 day tour**
