An excursion to Brixham and Torquay. The timeless working fishing port of Brixham is full of character and atmosphere; its narrow streets house many restaurants, cafes, pubs, tiny shops with their unusual gifts and souvenirs. We continue to Torquay often referred to as the 'Queen of the Riviera'. Palm lined promenades lead to the lively harbourside and marina, where pavement cafes and boutique shops abound.

4, 5 & 8 day tour

An excursion to Dawlish and Teignmouth. The picturesque Victorian town of Dawlish has decorative flower beds and the Dawlish brook that runs through the town is home to the famous black swans. Teignmouth is an historic port on the mouth of the Teign estuary. It has all the attractions of a seaside town, including a Victorian pier and a thriving mixture of shopping areas and interesting old back streets.

8 day tour

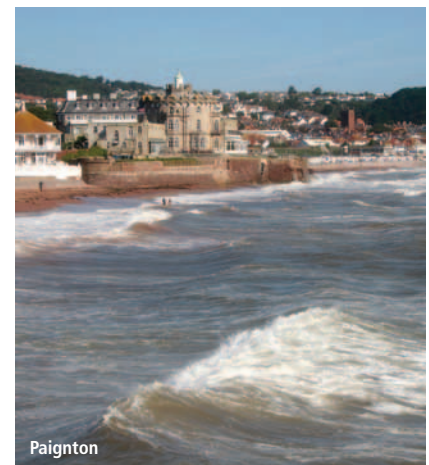
Today the coach travels to Dartmouth where impressive listed buildings line the harbour most adorned with hanging baskets of flowers in the summer months. Visitors can browse the narrow shopping cobbled streets or take a stroll alongside the busy river. We spend a few hours in this popular resort before taking the foot passenger ferry across the river to Kingswear where we board the famous Dart Steam railway for the return journey back to Paignton. The train travels seven miles along the most spectacular South Devon coast and the Dart Valley, a designated area of outstanding beauty. **5 & 8 day tour**
