Whitby

A full day excursion to the beautiful and famous city of York. For almost 2000 years York has played a leading role in England's history. Even without its crowning glory, a cathedral of breathtaking grandeur, it would be a city of outstanding beauty, interest and ageless charm. Its character is rich and colourful enough to be appreciated in the shortest of strolls down narrow streets, where little has changed since the Middle Ages. **5 & 6 day tour**

A full day excursion to Whitby and the North Yorkshire Moors. The quaint old fishing town of Whitby, standing on the mouth of the River Esk, is famous as the home of Captain Cook. In the narrow streets and alleys, fishermen still mend their nets outside the cottages. From the cobbled streets, 199 steps lead

to the parish church of St. Mary whose graveyard inspired Bram Stoker to include it in his novel 'Dracula'. Towering over both are the ruins of the historic Abbey of St. Hilda, which dominates the East Cliff. We leave Whitby and travel across the beautiful North Yorkshire Moors, a landscape of beautiful heathland and lush green valleys, to Goathland, a quaint moors village now famous as the setting for the popular television series 'Heartbeat'. Enjoy a drink in the Aidensfield Arms or walk across the road to inspect Scripps Garage. We return to Scarborough over the moors via Pickering.
