Skegness

Famed for its bracing sea air, Skegness is a traditional English seaside resort, blessed with three and a half miles of golden sandy beaches and beautiful seafront gardens bordering a long flat promenade. It has activities that would appeal to all, swimming facilities, excursions to nearby Gibraltar Point, a bird observatory and the Lincolnshire Wolds, a recognised area of natural beauty.

OUR INCLUDED EXCURSIONS

A full day excursion to the Cathedral city of Lincoln, with its narrow streets and quaint old buildings. The cathedral stands on the crest of a ridge rising high above the plateau occupied by the lower town and the river Witham. The castle has fine views and a mixed interior, part medieval and part 19th century. Located in the Cathedral Quarter is the Bailgate, the place to find specialist shops, trendy boutiques, and souvenir gifts while the High Street Quarter is where all the main High Street shops are located. **5 & 8 day tour**

Boston and the Fens excursion. We travel to Wainfleet where we visit the famous Batemans Brewery, one of the country's oldest family breweries. It is based on an old windmill, dating back two centuries and overlooks the River Steeping. Definitely one of the most picturesque of breweries. We continue through the Lincolnshire Fens to Boston, once an important sea port and home of the Pilgrim Fathers and famous 'Stump' church. **5 & 8 day tour**

An excursion to Mablethorpe and Louth. We travel to Mablethorpe, a glorious sandy beach resort with an excellent

selection of cafes, restaurants, bars and an interesting range of shops. We return via Louth, a busy market town with a maze of narrow streets and predominantly Georgian and early-Victorian architecture. There are some notable historic buildings including the 15th-century St. James' Church whose 295ft high spire, the tallest in England, dominates the skyline. **8 day tour**
