## ITINERARY

- Day 1** South Wales to Caernarfon
- Day 2** After breakfast we travel to Portmeirion. Clough Williams-Ellis built Portmeirion between the years 1925 to 1973 on his own private peninsula on the coast of Snowdonia. The village also has several shops and restaurants and is surrounded by the Gwyllt sub-tropical gardens and woodlands and miles of sandy beaches. We continue to Porthmadoc with its pretty harbour before returning to Caernarfon.
- Day 3** We travel to Llanberis and ride the famous Snowdon mountain railway. Your journey begins at the foot of the highest mountain in England and Wales. It continues through woodland, across an impressive viaduct before starting the long haul up to the ridge and onto the mountain itself. On fine days the views from the train are breathtaking. Enjoy the breathtaking panoramic views over the island of Anglesey and the Menai Strait as well as many of the surrounding peaks with mysterious and magical lakes nestled in the valleys between. We complete the day with a visit to Anglesey and Llanfair P.G.

**Day 4** Today we visit Llandudno; one of Britain's finest Victorian seaside resorts bringing together a lively mix of fun and entertainment. Its long crescent promenade, wide shopping streets, sweeping sands and wealth of family attractions make it a perfect destination whether you're riding the famous tramway or taking tea in the award winning tearoom at the Victoria shopping centre.
