ITINERARY

Day 1 South Wales to Arundel.

Day 2 We travel to the Weald and Downland open air museum. Set in 50 acres of beautiful Sussex countryside it is a very special place to wander amongst a fascinating collection of historic buildings dating from the 13th to the 19th century. We continue to Chichester, compact and intimate, with Roman walls and a medieval heart, there's history on every corner, from the Tudor Market Cross to the Georgian terraces.

Day 3 Today we visit Portsmouth. At the heart of the city is the Historic Dockyard where you can take a harbour cruise to see the naval ships and harbour fortifications from the water. Other attractions include Charles Dickens' birthplace, the D-Day museum featuring the Overlord Embroidery, Southsea Castle, the Royal Marines Museum and Portsmouth Cathedral. We return to the hotel via Arundel.

Day 4 We travel to Littlehampton and Bognor Regis before continuing to Worthing with its lengthy promenade and award winning pier. Enjoy leisurely strolls alongside floral displays whilst a walk on the pier gives a total new view of the town.

Day 5 Return to South Wales.

Southport

Southport is situated on England's North West coast in Merseyside. Its Victorian heritage is still a prominent feature and is reflected in its architecture, arcades, town centre, gardens and promenade. Southport Pier that opened in 1860 was closed during 1997 and totally refurbished and restored to its former glory. There are a wide variety of elegant shops on Lord Street, from small boutiques to the major department and high street stores.

ITINERARY

Day 1 Depart South Wales travelling to Southport.

Day 2 At leisure in resort, time to relax and explore your new surroundings.

Day 3 A tour of the Forest of Bowland, an area of outstanding Natural Beauty and Lancashire's hidden gem. The heart-stopping beautiful area of rolling hills, lush woodland, burbling rivers and amazing wildlife can make hours feel like minutes when taking in the stunning views. Originally a hunting reserve for the monarchy, part of the Forest is still owned by the Duchy of Lancaster. It is also purportedly the inspiration for the idyllic Shire of Lord of the Rings. We return via Clitheroe, Newton, Long Preston and Gisburn.

Day 4 On Thursday we enjoy a half day visit to Ormskirk, a traditional market town, combining both ancient and modern. The market itself is situated in a pedestrianised area surrounded by courtyards, charming arcades and specialist shops, and attracts shoppers from far and wide. This famous Charter Market dates back to 1286, when King Edward I granted a Royal Charter to the monks at nearby Burscough Abbey to hold a weekly market in Ormskirk town centre, and it brings an added buzz to the streets every Thursday and Saturday, when traders shout their wares from the colourful stalls. On our return to Southport we call in at Bygone Times, a unique shopping experience with something to interest and inspire every generation.

Day 5 Return to South Wales.
