ITINERARY

Day 1 Depart South Wales to our overnight's half-board accommodation.

Day 2 A leisurely day travelling through the central highlands to our hotel in Fort William.

Day 3 Today we enjoy a single leg train journey to Mallaig. The Jacobite Steam Railway has been described as one of the Great Railway Journeys of the World. Enjoy some of the most breathtaking and beautiful scenery in Scotland. The Glenfinnan viaduct and parts of the route were used extensively in the filming of the "Harry Potter" films. We return by coach along the 'Road to the Isles' with stunning scenery en route.

Day 4 At leisure in Fort William.

Day 5 Today we travel to Inverness and enjoy the spectacular train journey on the Kyle of Lochalsh line which is one of the world's most scenic rail journeys from Inverness on the east coast of Scotland through to Kyle of Lochalsh on the west. The views from the window are worth the fare alone but no matter where you are along its 80 miles, historic Scotland is only a few metres away. The terminus at Kyle of Lochalsh is the crossing point for the Isle of Skye. Nowadays there is no ferry, however the bridge can be crossed on foot or by bus and is only a short distance from the station.

Day 6 Depart Fort William travelling to our overnight's half board accommodation.

Day 7 Complete the journey home.
