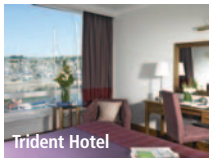

The medieval town of Kinsale is one of the most picturesque and fashionable resorts of the south-west coast of Ireland. The town is widely regarded as the Gourmet Capital of the South and deservedly so. The Kinsale chefs pride themselves on their reputation and with the fresh fish from the clean seas off the coastline and good wholesome food produce it is little wonder that the West Cork is gaining in stature as a veritable haven for gourmands.

ITINERARY

- Day 1** We travel to Fishguard for the afternoon sailing to Rosslare with Stena Line. We continue to our overnight's half board accommodation in the Wexford area.
- Day 2** After a leisurely breakfast we travel via Waterford and Youghal to Midleton where we take a refreshment stop at the Old Midleton Distillery, part of the Irish Distillers group famous for Jameson, Bushmills and Tullamore Dew. We complete the journey to Kinsale arriving with time to relax before dinner.
- Day 3** A day at leisure in Kinsale, relax and explore your new surroundings. The town nestles between the hills and the sea with a maze of narrow streets, traditional bars, restaurants and beautiful buildings. You can visit the Charles Fort - one of the finest examples of a star-shaped fort in the World, standing proudly at the mouth of the harbour or take in the stunning scenery from the water on a relaxing harbour cruise.
- Day 4** Today we enjoy the spectacular and varied scenery of the West Cork coastline. We visit Clonakilty, a town of tall spires and elegant squares. Once famous for the production of linen, this market town is today renowned for its black pudding, music pubs and hand painted Irish signs. We return to Kinsale via Innishannon a picturesque village of character and charm, immortalised by Alice Taylor in her books.
- Day 5** This morning we travel the short distance to Blarney to visit the Castle where you can take part in the long-standing tradition of kissing the Blarney Stone to receive "the gift of eloquence" (there is a charge to enter the castle and this is not included in the tour price). Do not miss the opportunity of visiting Blarney Woollen Mills, close to the village green, which offers the best range of genuine Irish products. We return to

- Cork and spend some time in the city before returning to Kinsale. Your final evening allows you the opportunity of individual fine dining with your choice of one of the fabulous 10 Kinsale Good Food Circle Restaurants.
- Day 6** Sadly its time to leave Kinsale after a leisurely hearty breakfast and travel to Cobh, a colourful harbour town with a rich maritime history and dominated by its majestic cathedral. We visit the Queenstown story where this highly imaginative visitor attraction tells the story of emigration from Cobh in the period of the famine in 1845 up to the era of the great Liners in the 1950s. We complete the journey to your overnight accommodation in the Wexford area.
- Day 7** After an early breakfast, we travel the short distance to Rosslare Harbour for the early morning sailing to Fishguard. We complete the journey arriving home late afternoon.
