We encompass the lively capital city of Edinburgh the dramatic coastline to Aberdeen, the Cairngorms to Inverness and the stunning journey to and from Kyle of Lochalsh

ITINERARY

Day 1 We have an early morning departure from South Wales to the Hilton hotel near Edinburgh Airport arriving in time to for dinner.

Day 2 We travel into Edinburgh where we include a guided city coach tour before allowing free time for shopping or sightseeing. We then drive to Leith and enjoy a tour of the Royal Yacht Britannia. This magnificent ship has played host to some of the most famous people in the world. But, above all, she was home to Her Majesty the Queen and the Royal Family. Now you are welcome on board to discover the heart and soul of this most special of royal residences. Dinner at the hotel in Edinburgh.

Day 3 We transfer you to the city centre in time to board the 11.27hr train to Aberdeen arriving at 13.46hrs. The train travels over the Firth of Forth and Tay bridges via Dundee, Arbroath and Montrose to Aberdeen. The remainder of the afternoon is at leisure in the Granite City. Dinner at the hotel in Aberdeen.

Day 4 Today you enjoy a beautiful scenic journey as we travel along the Dee Valley, over the rugged heather clad Cairngorms and Whiskey country in the Spey Valley to Inverness. Dinner at the hotel in Inverness.

Day 5 Enjoy a relaxing breakfast and a few hours free time before boarding the 11.01hr train to Kyle of Lochalsh, arriving 13.26hrs. Leaving Inverness, the line curves around the western edge of the Beaully Firth to Dingwall before heading west through mountains and lakes, through Strath Bran and Glen Carron, before the final few miles from Strath Carron, alongside Loch Carron into the small port of Kyle of Lochalsh. Enjoy the views to the Isle of Skye before we board the coach and have a memorable scenic journey back to Inverness. We stop at one of the most iconic images of Scotland, Eilean Donan castle, situated on an island at the point where three great sea lochs meet before continuing through the Western Highlands past Loch Cluanie to Fort Augustus and the seven locks of the Caledonian Canal. We complete the journey driving along the shores of Loch Ness past Urquart Castle arriving at the hotel in time for dinner in Inverness.

Day 6 After breakfast we board the 09.18hr train to Glasgow arriving 12.45hrs. The journey begins with the climb over Slochd Summit to Aviemore – gateway to the Cairngorms, then Kingussie, Newtonmore, through the pass of Drumochter to Blair Atholl and Pitlochry and finally through the heart of the Grampian Mountains to Perth, Stirling and finally Glasgow. The remainder of the afternoon is at leisure in the city. Dinner at the hotel in Glasgow.

Day 7 We depart our hotel for the return journey to South Wales.
