ITINERARY

- Day 1** Travel to Drymen. Dinner is followed by an evening of story telling.
Day 2 Today we have a tour of the Trossachs visiting Callander and Loch Katrine.
Day 3 We visit Stirling where you can visit the Old Town and historic castle, overlooking the site of 'Braveheart' Sir William Wallace's greatest victory, Stirling's Old Town with its bustling city centre boasts the finest concentration of historic buildings in Scotland. Beautifully preserved medieval and Renaissance churches and mansions cluster around the Old Town, flanked by cobbled streets, period street furniture and Victorian styled iron work.
Day 4 We enjoy a circular tour travelling to Luss on Loch Lomond. Loch Lomond is the single biggest expanse of inland water in the British Isles. We drive via Arrochar and the Firth of Clyde before we encounter Helensburgh's graceful architecture, broad avenues, piers and promenades.
Day 5 Return to South Wales.

There are many famous places in Scotland, none more so than the impact the Firth of Forth and Clyde have had on Scotland's proud heritage. On our leisurely but action packed tour you will cruise on one of Scotland's most beautiful Lochs in a steamship, be hoisted over 35 mtrs by the world's only boat lift and marvel on the Forth cruise hopefully spotting plenty of wildlife and see Loch Lomond and Dunoon crossing the Clyde.

ITINERARY

- Day 1** Travel to Dunblane.
Day 2 Morning at leisure before we depart to Loch Katrine where you take your seat on the Steamer Sir Walter Scott for a cruise of the lake listening to tales and legends as you cruise past some of the best of Scotland's finest scenery. We return to the hotel via Callander.
Day 3 We travel to nearby Falkirk and enjoy a boat cruise and return lift on the Falkirk Wheel. Measuring 115 feet, The Falkirk Wheel is the worlds only rotating boat lift and is used to connect the Forth and Clyde and Union canals in central Scotland. This magnificent, mechanical marvel has been constructed to 21st Century, state-of-the-art engineering and it is already being recognised as an iconic landmark worthy of Scotland's traditional engineering expertise. We continue to the Firth of Forth where we take a cruise under the Forth Bridge out toward Inchcolm Island where we will hopefully view the local wildlife including seals, dolphins and puffins.
Day 4 A spectacular day travelling via Loch Lomond and Arrochar with its mountain backdrop, down Loch Fyne, Loch Eck and the famous Holy Loch to Dunoon where we board the ferry to Gourock returning to the hotel over the Erskine Bridge.
Day 5 Return to South Wales.
