The 15th century ruins incorporate the Blarney Stone, which is said to give the gift of eloquence to all who kiss it (there is a charge to enter the castle and this is not included in the tour price). We then visit the Queenstown Story based in the disused portions of the railway station at Cobh. This highly imaginative visitor attraction tells the story of emigration from Cobh in the period of the famine in 1845 up to the era of the great Liners in the 1950s.
- Day 4** This morning we visit the famous Waterford Crystal which houses the largest collection of Waterford Crystal in the world. We include a guided factory tour, giving you first hand access to all areas of traditional crystal production and shop before returning to Tramore with the afternoon at leisure.
- Day 5** After an early breakfast we travel to Rosslare harbour for the early morning sailing to Fishguard and continue our journey home.
