Little Trains of Austria



The central Tyrol is an area of breathtaking scenery where lush green valleys, shimmering streams, towering waterfalls and majestic snow capped peaks form a tapestry rich in colour and wildlife. We are pleased to offer you the opportunity to view this magnificent scenery from a different perspective following in the footsteps of those first intrepid tourists who first visited this region by train

ITINERARY

Day 1 We travel to Dover / Folkestone for the short sea ferry / shuttle crossing to Calais before continuing to our overnight half board accommodation..

Day 2 We complete the journey to the Tyrol and the Hotel Sonnschein to be greeted by your hostess, Gill Thaler, and enjoy a welcome drink followed by dinner.

Day 3 Today we travel to Jenbach, where we join the original Achenseebahn cog railway, which dates back to 1889. These are some of the oldest steam engines in the world still to be used for public transport! The train winds its way up above the Inn Valley to the shores of the largest Alpine lake in the Tyrol, Lake Achen. Perhaps take a boat cruise, or enjoy a stroll by the lake. We then continue to Rattenberg, the oldest town in the Tyrol, now famous for its crystal and glass showrooms.

Day 4 Full day trip including the Ziller Valley Steam Train and Mayrhofen. On July 31st, 1902 this wonderful narrow gauge steam train made its first journey from Jenbach to Mayrhofen. In 1965 it was almost closed to make way for a new road, which was being constructed. Fortunately it was saved and still operates today along the Ziller Valley.

Day 5 Enjoy a day at leisure in Niederau and take advantage of the wide range of leisure facilities which the Hotel Sonnschein has to offer, or take a local bus ride to the nearby

town of Wörgl and its shopping possibilities. Following dinner, enjoy an evening of fun and entertainment at a traditional Tyrolean Folklore Evening in the sister hotel, the Hotel Harfenwirt, a short walk from the Sonnschein.

Day 6 Today we visit Salzburg, the Mozart capital of the world and home of the ever-popular movie "The Sound of Music". The guided walking tour of this magical city will show you the highlights. There will be free time for shopping and sightseeing. Perhaps take a stroll this evening after dinner to the nearby historic Gasthof Bichlwirt and enjoy an evening of traditional harp music (may take place on another evening).

Day 7 Today we have a journey on the Pinzgauer Nostalgic Train from Mittersill to Krimml. For more than 100 years the narrow-gauge railway has been winding along the Salzach River and past the national park Hohe Tauern through the picturesque valley. The nostalgic steam train will bring you to Krimml and Krimmler waterfalls, the 5th highest in the world. It is possible to get very close to this breathtaking natural spectacle but it does involve a fairly level walk of around 15-20 minutes, but well worth the effort.

Day 8 We journey to our overnight half board accommodation.

Day 9 We continue the journey to Calais for the afternoon crossing to Dover / Folkestone and complete the journey home.
