Door to Door

New Tour

This beautiful region of Austria offers an impressive combination of mountains and lakes, rivers and forests, delightful villages and prosperous cities, all just waiting to be discovered by you. We have arranged a varied programme at our new hotel featuring traditional local festivals whenever possible such as the 'Mountains in Flames' and the Harvest Festival featuring the return of livestock from summer pastures in the hills and numerous country festivals.

## ITINERARY

**Day 1** Depart from South Wales travelling to Folkestone / Dover for the short sea ferry / shuttle crossing to Calais continuing to our overnight half board accommodation.

**Day 2** After breakfast we continue our journey to the Eder Hotel in Maria Alm.

**Day 3** At leisure in Maria Alm. Relax, enjoy the village walk and explore our new surroundings.

**Day 4** Today we visit Salzburg, the City of Music, birthplace of Mozart and home to the "Sound of Music". Window shop in the famous "Getreidegasse", enjoy the beauty of the Mirabell Gardens and marvel at the spectacular Hohensalzburg Fortress dating back to the 11th century. A guided city walk will lead you through this medieval city before enjoying some leisure time in the city centre before returning to Maria Alm for your evening meal.

**Day 5** Today will offer some of the finest scenery in Europe as we travel the Grossglockner high Alpine road. At 3798 m

above sea level, it is Austria's highest mountain and the highest mountain in the Alps east of the Brenner Pass. We stop at the Franz Josef's Hohe and see the largest glacier in the eastern Alps at an amazing 9 kilometers long!

**Day 6** After breakfast we travel to the charming village of Berchtesgaden. Here you can spend some quality time enjoying the facilities on offer and if you wish, take the optional excursion to see the fantastic views from the 'Eagle's Nest'.

**Day 7** A half day tour to Zell am See. The afternoon is at leisure to relax or finish that last minute souvenir shopping

**Day 8** Depart our hotel and retrace the journey to our overnight half board accommodation.

**Day 9** We continue to Calais for the afternoon ferry / shuttle crossing and complete the journey home.
