Imperial Cities

The Historic Habsburg Empire

For four centuries, three of Europe's most beautiful and historic cities, Budapest, Vienna and Prague have belonged to a very complex central European area known as the Habsburg Empire. The holiday highlights begin in the Golden City of Prague before arriving in Budapest with its famous Fishermen's Bastion and Old Buda. The tour culminates with a journey across the Hungarian Great Plain to Vienna, the 'Queen of the Danube' and former capital of the Habsburg realm

ITINERARY

- Day 1** Travelling to Dover and the short sea ferry crossing to Calais continuing to our overnight's half board accommodation in Germany.
- Day 2** We continue to our second overnight's half board accommodation in Dresden travelling through Germany's Thuringia region.
- Day 3** We enjoy a walking tour of Dresden before departing for Prague and our two night's accommodation at the Hotel Christie where we meet our Tour Guide who will escort our group until we leave Vienna. Dinner will be served in the hotel this evening.
- Day 4** Guided City Tour of Prague. Our City Guide will show you some of the cultural treasures of this city, including the "Old Town", the original heart of the city, with its sights such as the "Powder Gate" and the "Old Town Hall". Visit the "Castle District", including the "Golden Lane", which was named after the goldsmiths who lived there in the 17th century. The afternoon is at leisure before joining in the fun at the "Czech Beer Party" this evening, where traditional beers and food will be served in a typical Czech "Pub" in the city.
- Day 5** We depart Prague and journey eastward to the Slovakian Republic, making a stop in the capital city of Bratislava before continuing into Hungary, arriving in Budapest late afternoon. Check in at the Hotel Lions Garden in Budapest where dinner will be served this evening.
- Day 6** Today we have a guided city tour of Budapest. Our guide will explain secrets of this impressive city, split into two by the River Danube. Buda, lying on the hills and is home to the impressive Fishermen's Bastion (entrance included). Pest is home to the "Citadel" and the Heroes' Square. Budapest has many cobbled streets and shopping lanes, the famous Opera House and the Parliament. The afternoon is at leisure before we enjoy a typical Hungarian Czardas Folklore Evening

including a traditional dinner and Gypsy music.

Day 7 We depart Budapest and head westward to the Austrian border and the Austrian province of Burgenland, with its curious blend of Austrian and Hungarian styles. Stop at Lake Neusiedl and enjoy a typical "Pannonian" lunch. After lunch a horse and carriage will carry you through the vineyards to the lakeshore for a brief boat cruise on Lake Neusiedl. We continue to the Hotel Bosei in Vienna, arriving late afternoon. Dinner will be served this evening in your hotel.

Day 8 After breakfast enjoy a guided tour enjoying the highlights of Vienna, a city of romance and music. View the famous "Ringstrasse", home to the Opera House, the Burg Theatre and the Houses of Parliament. See many famous sights including Vienna's Cathedral, the "Stephansdom". Today's highlight will be a visit to the Palace of Schönbrunn, the former Imperial Residence. Enjoy some leisure before heading to the Prater Fairground for a ride on the "Big Wheel" (of "The Third Man" movie fame) and then on to the wine village of Grinzing, located on the city outskirts, for an evening including wine, dinner and music in one of the traditional wine inns or "Heurigen".

Day 9 After an early breakfast we travel to our overnight half board accommodation in Germany

Day 10 Travel to Calais for the mid afternoon ferry crossing and complete the journey home
