Germany's Hanseatic North Sea Coast

New Tour

Door to Door

The Hanseatic League is forever linked with European history. The importance of commerce, strong member towns and many long-standing traditions are all vestiges associated with this once powerful trade alliance. Since reunification, the Baltic Coast has benefited from a major restoration of its historic structures including the ornate gabled houses that hark back to the days of the Hanseatic League.

ITINERARY

Day 1 Travel to Folkestone / Dover for the short sea / shuttle crossing to Calais and continue to our overnight's half board accommodation.

Day 2 We continue the journey travelling via Bremen and Hamburg to Travemünde arriving with time to relax before enjoying a welcome drink and dinner.

Day 3 At leisure in Travemünde. Relax and explore this popular seaside resort at the mouth of the River Trave. The resort has a wide sandy beach, busy promenade, a pleasant little shopping area, cafes, bars and souvenir shops. The river is a busy shipping lane with many of the Baltic ferries generating interest as they navigate the narrow river entrance on their way to the port.

Day 4 Today we take the short walk to the promenade for a riverboat cruise into the heart of Lübeck for our included guided walking tour of this historic city. The medieval Altstadt, or old city, is now a UNESCO World Heritage Site containing many architectural styles along with narrow cobblestone streets and beautifully restored buildings. Visit the Cathedral and Niederegger cafe, situated opposite the town hall selling delicious pastries and Lübeck's famous discovery, marzipan. We return to the hotel by coach. (Tour may run in the opposite direction depending on sailing times)

Day 5 We depart after breakfast and drive over the Fehmarnsund Bridge (described as "the biggest coat-hanger of the world") for a guided coach tour of the Island of Fehmarn discovering its cultural, historical and natural beauty.

Day 6 Today we have a half day tour to Schwerin. Founded in 1160, Schwerin is one of Germany's oldest and most stunning cities, the crowning glory of which is its fabulous castle, complete with glittering golden towers. Surrounded almost entirely by lakes, the old town brims with well preserved

townhouses and remnants of its past life as a regal town.

Day 7 Sadly we depart after breakfast we travel to our overnight half board accommodation.

Day 8 Travel to Calais for the mid afternoon ferry / shuttle crossing and complete the journey home.
