## Edwards fare information

You need to have a valid Edwards bus ticket or pass for every journey you make. If you don't, you may be asked to pay the full fare for the journey again or you may be asked to pay a penalty fare of £20 within 10 days.

Single (one journey) and Return (there and back) tickets can be bought on buses. There's no need to worry about having the correct money – our drivers give change. However, it can speed up boarding times if you have the correct fare available.

## No cash? Not a problem!

**We've introduced contactless payments on all our services.**

You can make contactless payments on all Edwards Bus services in South Wales for any ticket up to £30, using any Mastercard or Visa card displaying the contactless symbol.

### **Here's how it works...**

Simply tell the driver what ticket you want to buy and tap your contactless card on the ticket machine. You'll get a receipt along with a ticket for your journey. And to make things even easier, you can also use Apple or Google Pay.
